For more than two decades the Malaga-based company Surterráneo Teatro has been producing theatrical pieces that stand out for their thorough process of investigation, search for new dramatic languages and powerful visual aesthetics. Over the last ten years the company has specialised in interventions in non-conventional venues and was the first to develop immersive theatre in Malaga. It was the resident company of the Central de Actuantes at La Térmica cultural centre for seven years, where it produced and programmed more than twenty shows. The Antequera Dolmens Site and the Russian Museum of Malaga are other venues at which the company has performed.
