Their emotional relationships are very confusing; it is not clear if there is romance or abuse of power until they confess to each other. Caught in a role and in a social class, they are swept along by the destiny of their names when Lope de Vega's fiction mixes with their experiences. The verse enters little by little, without them noticing it, and then in an organised manner when Fuente proposes a space called spontaneous microphone as a marketing strategy. But this recreational space leads to a complaint: thus the popular argument transcends time, in a banner that has no past. Fuente ends like in the original work, assassinated by popular fury."
