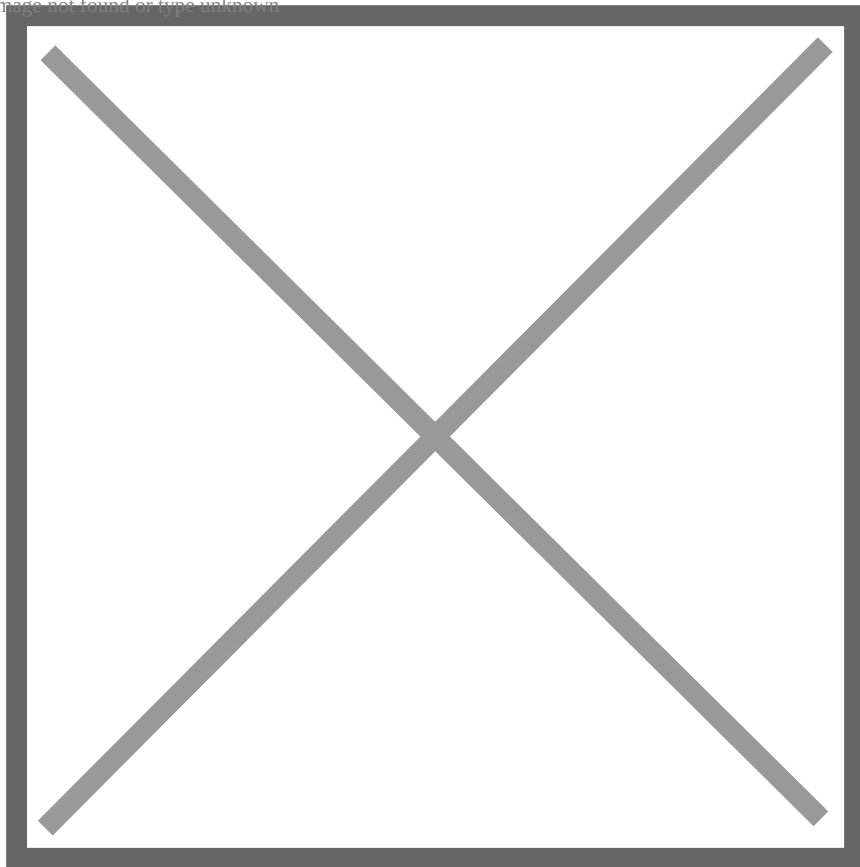

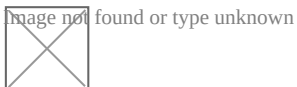

A group of tourists on a cultural visit to the Theatre of Epidauros in Greece interrupt with their talking the rehearsal of a play about Aristophanes.
