I don't usually look back because it makes me dizzy; and, just in case, to avoid stumbling again over the same stones, because I have enough with the new ones I stumble over. But it doesn't matter, I'll keep on falling as if there's no tomorrow; in other words, like everyone.

That said: 30 years and **ONLY** 11 concertos. Not one more.

This is not a typical tour (at least not one of mine), no: it's a celebration at which we'll play the whole record, from beginning to end, at some of the most majestic and beautiful venues of this country.

Revolver, a well-known Spanish rock band, was founded in 1989 by the singer and composer Carlos Goñi, who made it his hallmark, using it as a pseudonym to publish his albums. The band has had a very prolific career full of hits and great live concerts that have converted Gofi in one of the most emblematic Spanish artists.
