Five women talk, because they need to talk, about how they have lived their lives and their art and why there is a restlessness deep in their chest, between the heart and the lungs, where you feel and breathe. Maybe it is pain, or age, or loneliness, or love that also hurts sometimes, or laughter that is stuck there. But all of them remember their mothers, which is why they are all the daughters."

Todas las hijas is a story of terror. A possessive mother drags her daughter to insanity. Fear to close your eyes and dream. Childhood memories of abuse. The nightmare of a relationship marked by violence. No sleeping, no eating, turning into a ghost, a vampire, a monster. *Todas las hijas* is the story of the life of five brave women: the exorcism of fear to overcome fear, a game that at times can be very dangerous and at times very funny. *Todas las hijas* is about playing, about fearing and struggling. To fight and to laugh. It is a journey through female fears.” Andrés Lima **Andrés Lima, 2019 National Theatre Award, winner of five Max awards, including Best Stage Director, has created the dramaturgy of *Todas las hijas* based on the actresses’ real testimony, their experiences, their wishes, their fears. This exorcism has been carried out in workshops held for a year and a half.**
